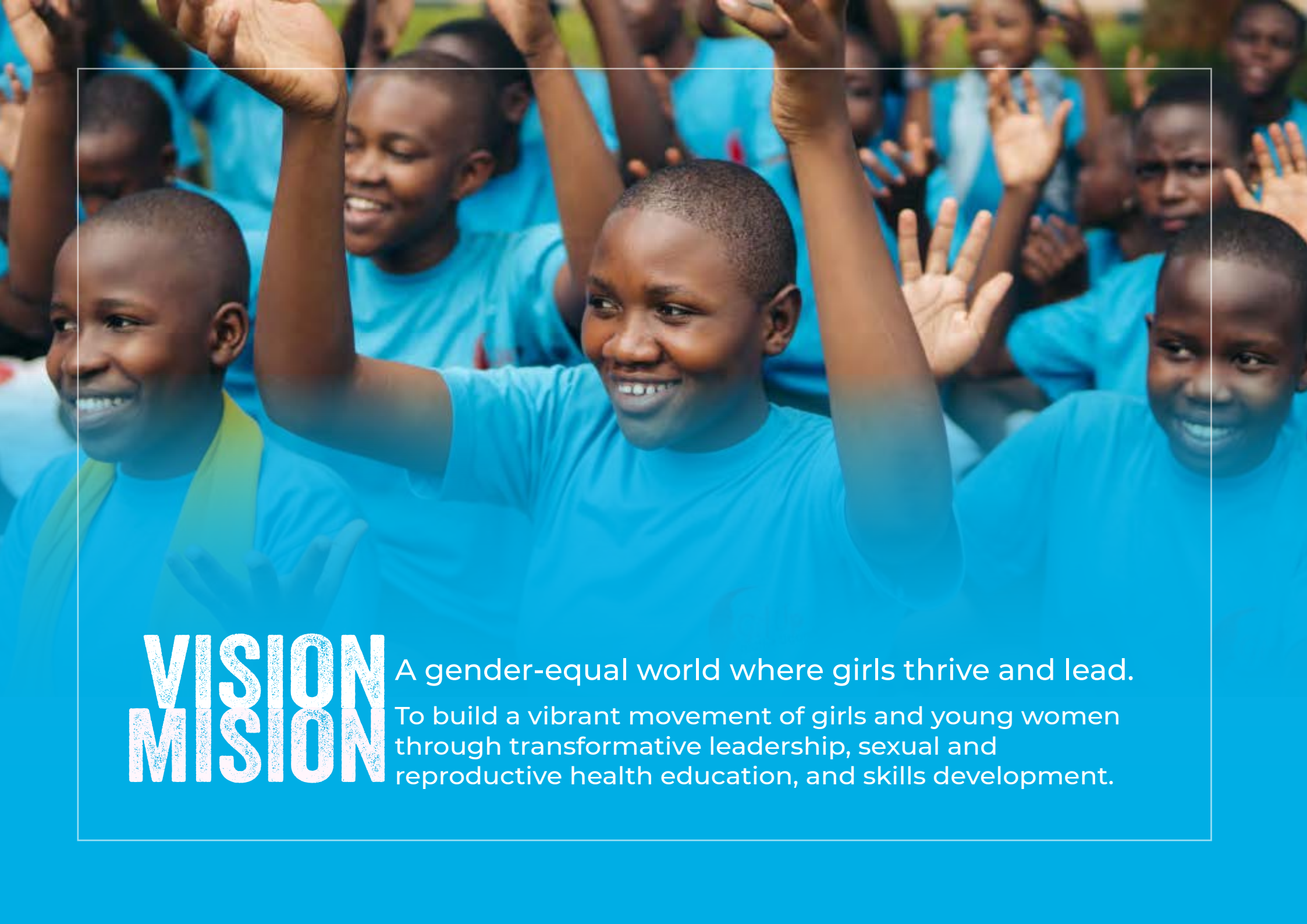

Supports out-of-school girls and young women with entrepreneurial skills and economic independence
