- ❖Women and young girls living in the informal settlements bear the brunt of all forms of gender inequalities
- **❖85**% of women and girls in Kenya's informal settings experience gender-based violence compared to the general population at 36%
- Less than 20% of girls (15-19rs) complete secondary education and even fewer proceed to higher level education

Mission

• Advance education, health and socioeconomic opportunities that empower adolescents and youths in Kenya's informal settlements through capacity building, referrals and linkages.

- Population Connection supports HKSAI's HEEP (Hope through Education Empowerment Program),
- Contributing to increased rates of enrolment, retention and graduation from institutions of higher levels of learning

Impact

- 25 adolescent girls successfully transitioned to High school
- 77 graduated with skills from TVET
- 7 individuals supported with funds for star ups
- 1,500 adolescent girls and young women mentored
- \$1,200 community members sensitized on gender issues including SRHR
