Nature Conservation

Our nature conservation programs prevent extinction by protecting key habitats for endangered species. We focus our programs in biodiversity hotspots for endangered wildlife, to amplify our mission of saving species from extinction through grassroots community engagement. By investing in the local community, we seek to expand their grassroots capacity, making conservation projects more sustainable while providing opportunities that reduce environmental degradation and biodiversity loss.

Healthy Communities for Healthy Habitats

At the community level, we focus on gender integration between conservation and gender equality, advocating for women's basic rights as education, basic healthcare and economic opportunities in order to concretely increase the quality of life in their communities.. We support women by providing them with voluntary access to reproductive healthcare and information about reproductive rights.

Sustainable Livelihoods

We promote and facilitate training for women to adopt environmentally conscious lifestyles and businesses. We aim to facilitate economic opportunities for women through our sustainable and conservation initiatives in order for our partner communities to remain stewards of their land.


