








### CERVICAL CANCER PREVENTION



CERVICAL CANCER IS THE LEADING CAUSE OF CANCER RELATED DEATH AMONG GUATEMALAN WOMEN.

WE PROVIDE RAPID SCREENING AND IMMEDIATE TREATMENT OF PRECANCEROUS CELLS USING VISUAL INSPECTION WITH ACETIC ACID (VIAA) AND THERMOCOAGULATION.






## **VASECTOMY SERVICES**


